AGREEMENT ON THE PARTNERSHIP FOR KNOWLEDGE

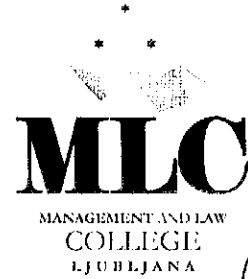
Article 1

On the basis of their common interests, MLC Ljubljana and IPB Bragança as equal partners conclude the Cooperation Agreement (on the partnership for knowledge), aimed at developing the creative academic and business environment. The partners will cooperate in order to develop the comprehensive opportunities and benefits in the provision of study, scientific and research as well as development activities.

Article 2

The partners will direct their activities towards the achievement of the following objectives:

- substantive improvement of the management and law study programme and other study programmes in the field of business sciences, which will increase the attractiveness and competitiveness of the study programme and consequently the employability of graduates;
- the development of quality connections by including new partners from the international business and higher education area;
- the promotion of partnership by participating in development projects that will support such networking activities in the domestic, European and wider international area.



Article 3

The partners will cooperate when they estimate that the cooperation contributes to the improvement of the quality of one of the following activities:

- professional development of students of both partners and the related study activities: visiting lecturers, study excursions, practical training in the form of student practice;
- the development of higher education study process of both partners, following the example of modern business schools;
- active inclusion in international and domestic research and consulting projects in which the parties take part due to the expected development benefits;
- the organisation of scientific and professional meetings and other forms of cooperation that will contribute to the competitiveness of operations of the parties to the Agreement.

The partners will strive for a synergistic cooperation also in other fields which are directly or indirectly related to the subject of the Agreement and within their competence.

Article 4


The partners agree that the parties may advertise the partnership in their presentation and other promotional materials. The partners agree to enter the “partnerships for knowledge”, developed by any of the parties to the Agreement.

Article 5

The partners will normally plan and confirm joint actions contained in this Agreement in advance and in writing.

The costs of the implementation of activities based on this Agreement shall be borne by the partners in accordance with the prior agreement and the principle of good business practice. Neither partner is responsible for meeting any possible costs if the manner in which they shall be borne was not agreed upon in advance.

The cooperation under this document shall be valid for an indefinite period and may be amended or supplemented if so agreed by the parties.




Article 6
